We are happy to announce that we plan to reopen our Community Dining Program in Shortsville in May. It has been a year since we closed due to the COVID pandemic. New York State will allow indoor dining at 75% capacity by March 19th. The Office for the Aging would like to know if you are interested in attending the congregate meal site at Shortsville Fire Hall, located at 5 Sheldon Street, Shortsville.

Please know that we will strictly adhere to New York guidelines for safety protocol. Participants will be expected to wear masks unless eating.

Ontario County Office for the Aging will provide a nutritious, mid-day meal to community members 60 years of age or older. We will be serving in the fire hall at 12:00 pm Monday through Thursday. There is no fee for the meal but contributions are accepted. The suggested contribution is \$3.00 per meal but no one is denied a meal if they are unable to contribute.

To participate in the Community Dining Program, a registration form needs to be completed on an annual basis.
