Inspection of the Manchester-Shortsville Sewage Treatment plant was performed on August 8,2018 with Chief Operator Gordon Eddington. The Village STP was found to be in satisfactory compliance with the requirements as set forth in the State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit. They praised Gordon Eddington in doing an outstanding job in operating the facility.

Problems with Outlet Road Pump Station control unit. Level controller is not working properly. Equipment supplier will check it out. All work on this is billed to the Town of Manchester who bills Mormon Church.

Received new composting permit from DEC. The permit is valid until 2023
Having problems with lawn mower. It is 14 years old. Looking on New York State bid for pricing of new machine.
Maintenance on equipment-everything running fine.
