The meeting was called to order by Commissioner/Mayor of Manchester Michael Buttaccio at 4pm

The minutes of March 21,2023 and were prepared beforehand by the Recording Clerk and on motion by Trustee Henry seconded by Trustee Trimm, voted upon and carried unanimously-to accept as prepared and placed on file.

Treasurer Gurewitch presented the April Operation and Maintenance Treasurers Report a motion was made by Trustee Henry seconded by Trustee Lonneville voted upon and unanimously carried, as prepared and placed on file.

Trustee Henry made a motion to transfer \$50,000.00 from Equipment JG8130.2 to Electric JG8130.422 seconded by Trustee Lonneville, voted upon and carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mayor Mink and seconded by Trustee Henry to start payment on the Bond on August 1,2024 voted upon and carried all"AYES"

GORDON EDDINGTON REPORT:

- 1.Ultra Violet Disinfection project is 99% completed. The system went on line April 25,2023 ahead of the May 1,2023 deadline. Samples of the effluent for five (5) days in a row proved that the system is operating effectively.
2. Running press and composing sludge.
- 3.Pole barn covering the UV equipment is 99% completed. We are waiting on some trim material.
- 4.All flow meters were adjusted and calibrated for NYSDEC compliance.
- 5.Completed and submitted to NYSDEC the five (5) year renewal of sludge composting permit.
6. Preparing a list of things at plant that need work on replacement.
- 7.Normal operations

Would like to enlarge the compost space. Gordon will check on cost
