After a brief discussion on the bid for sandblasting and coating the south clarifier tank in the amount of \$72,100.00, that would be given to Ahart Industrial Services LLC, 2245 Pond Road, Bloomfield, N.Y. Gordon Eddington would also recommend that the Board allows a budget for extra work needed that may be discovered as the project progresses to a total amount of \$130,000.00. A motion was made to accept the bid from Ahart Industrial Services LLC and increase the budget to \$130,000.00 for the coating and sandblasting of the South clarifier tank by Trustee Henry, seconded by Trustee Fine, voted upon and unanimously carried.
