The minutes of the previous meeting were prepared beforehand by the Village Clerk-Treasurer and on motion by Trustee Trimm, seconded by Trustee Langdon, voted and carried unanimously to accept as prepared and placed on file. Motion was made by Trustee Langdon, seconded by Trustee Trimm, voted and carried unanimously to accept the May 2025 Trial Balance (Edmunds), Bank Statement (CNB), Revenue/Expenditure Analysis (Edmunds).

Board Items:

DPW report was given by Trustee Langdon. Current DPW updates: Booth Street is scheduled to be paved in the middle of July, DPW is down to one vehicle, water repair on West Main Street is complete, grounds are getting ready for CHC carnival, and Mayor Corino will be contact Van Bortel Ford to find out the status of the new vehicle.

Chief Jason Wagner presented the board with the Monthly Report for May 2025, Incident Run Log and gave community updates. Chief Wagner states that Finger Lakes Ambulance is now their ALS partner.

Bob Johnston presented the board with prepared drawings for 1755 Pioneer Road to connect to the village sewer. Town of Manchester, Gordon Eddington from Joint Sewer are aware of Mr. Johnston’s plans. The plan is for the property to become a brewery.

Bob Woodhams asked for permission to close part of the village parking lot during the parade for the Depot Restaurant. All members of the board stated that this is allowed. Trustee Trimm stated that she owed Mr.

Woodhams an apology because during the last meeting she agreed to have the seniors use alternative entrance during CHC meeting, but now she doesn’t agree. Trustee Trimm stated that she did not want to be responsible for telling the seniors they had to use an alternate entrance. Mr. Woodhams stated that the seniors should show respect when they walk through and interrupt the meeting. Chief Wagner stated that there are code complaint gates that can be installed since the staircase of the landing where the alternate entrance is located is a concern of Trustee Trimm. Chief Wagner stated that everyone will work together until it is figured out.

Motion was made by Trustee Langdon, seconded by Mayor Corino, to allow the Tap Truck Rochester to serve alcohol for a benefit at Budd Park on August 16th as long as they get the required liquor license.

Trustee Langdon made a motion, seconded by Mayor Corino, to enter into Executive Session at 6:47 P.M. for the purposes of an employee’s probationary period ending.

Trustee Langdon made a motion, seconded by Mayor Corino, to end Executive Session at 6:58 P.M.

Motion was made by Trustee Langdon, seconded by Mayor Corino, voted and carried unanimously to retain Nathan Lewis as Laborer permanently.

There was no further business to come before the board, so the meeting was adjourned by motion of Trustee Trimm, seconded by Trustee Langdon and carried at 6:59 P.M.
