Mayor Corino opened the Village Board Meeting order at 6:00 P.M.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the previous meeting were prepared beforehand by the Village Clerk-Treasurer and on motion by Trustee Langdon, seconded by Trustee Trimm, voted and carried unanimously to accept as prepared and placed on file. Motion was made by Trustee Trimm, seconded by Trustee Langdon, voted and carried unanimously to accept the October 2025 Trial Balance (Edmunds), Bank Statement (CNB), Revenue/Expenditure Analysis (Edmunds).

Motion was made by Trustee Trimm, seconded by Trustee Langdon, voted and carried unanimously to audit and approve the following bills for payment and all budget transfers:

Board Items:

Ryan Seeber addressed the board regarding Building Permit #55-2025. Mr. Seeber resides at 29 Water Street and would like to have solar panels installed on his roof. Currently, the Village of Shortsville code does not include solar panels thereby making Code Enforcement unable to approve the permit. Mr. Seeber previously presented the board the information packet from Empire Solar Solutions, LLC for review. Mr. Seeber stated that the only part that may change would be some of the electrical work. The board had no further questions for Mr. Seeber. Motion made by Trustee Langdon, seconded by Trustee Trimm, voted and carried unanimously to approve Building Permit #55-2025. Building permit will now be forwarded to Code Enforcement.

Dan DeClerk addressed the board about Red Jacket Junior Baseball/Softball. Mr. DeClerk would like to use Budd Park as part of the program for practices and tournaments. He explained that the program hosts around 140 kids. He would like to work with the village to see what work can be done on the field. The discussion included having a Day of Pride in the spring to prepare the field, that the season runs from April to September, and that he is also working with the Village of Manchester and Town of Manchester and an engineer that can help him identify some issues that may need to be addressed (drainage and leveling). Trustee Trimm raised the concern about how often the baseball/softball would want the field to make sure it doesn't take away from residents using the park. Mr. DeClerk stated that the majority of utilization would be during the week with the exception of approximately three weekends for tournaments. The village and Mr. DeClerk will follow up when it gets closer to spring to look at the field to see what work can be done. Mr. DeClerk stated that he will get the village dates for usage as soon as possible.
