Board Items:

Randall Ott, resident at 32 Booth Street, inquired as to any future plans or updates on water work for the area of Booth Street and Maple Avenue after the water break that happened last September. The board informed Mr. Ott that the village currently has a couple proposals from Mark Porretta Excavating but have not decided on exactly what work will be done there. Village will consult further with Rich Vienna for specific details on the proposals. Trustee Schaertl stated that the update from village attorney regarding dog park is that we are already doing what he recommends with the exception of regulations. Dog park group will draft an agreement to share with the village so that a written agreement will be in place before the village opens the park up. Motion was made by Trustee Schaertl, seconded by Trustee Langdon, voted and carried unanimously to hire Edward Ruthven as Department of Public Works Supervisor. Chief Jason Wagner gave the Monthly Report for June 2026 and the Incident Run log for the Shortsville Fire Department. Chief Wagner stated that the FD will have a recruiting table set up during the street dance. Also, Chief Wagner is working on a policy to expand the body camera program to all. Trustee Schaertl is wondering if NSYEG can check the gas usage at the Fire Hall as the utility bills are high. Chief Wagner stated that there are some exhausts system issues and he will have it looked into.

There was no further business to come before the board, so the meeting was adjourned by motion of Trustee Langdon, seconded by Trustee Schaertl and carried at 6:54 P.M.
